Housing Supply Overview

Summer is right around the corner. In addition to corn on the cob, grilled steaks and your favorite outdoor activity, be watching for increased seller activity in response to constrained inventory levels and rising prices. For the 12-month period spanning June 2012 through May 2013, Closed Sales in the Fort Wayne region were up 10.6 percent overall. The price range with the largest gain in sales was the \$150,001 to \$300,000 range, where they increased 24.1 percent.

The overall Median Sales Price was up 8.1 percent to \$107,000. The property type with the largest price gain was the Single-Family segment, where prices increased 7.4 percent to \$105,000. The overall Percent of Original List Price Received at Sale was up 0.5 percent to 92.1.

Market-wide, inventory levels were down 14.7 percent. The property type that lost the least inventory was the Single-Family segment, where it decreased 14.0 percent. That amounts to 5.4 months supply for Single-Family homes and 5.0 months supply for Condos.

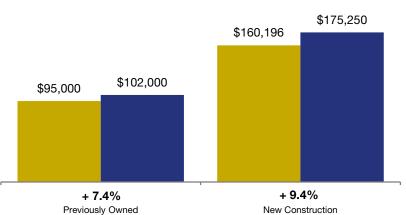

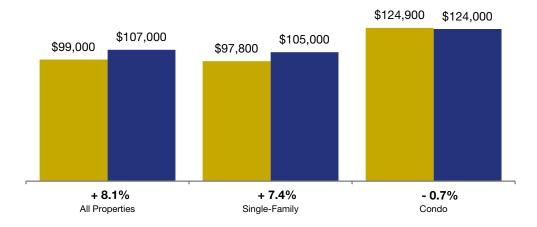

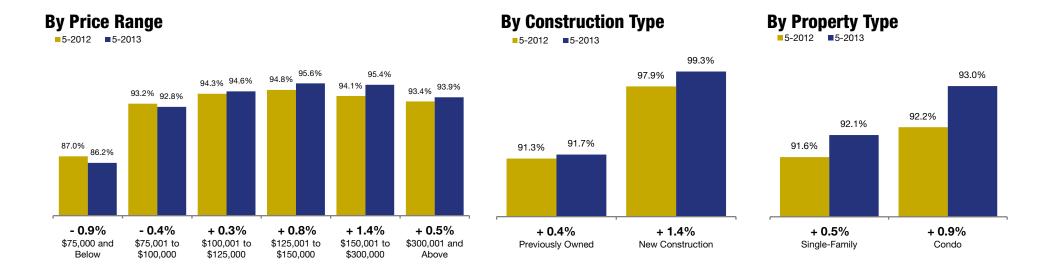

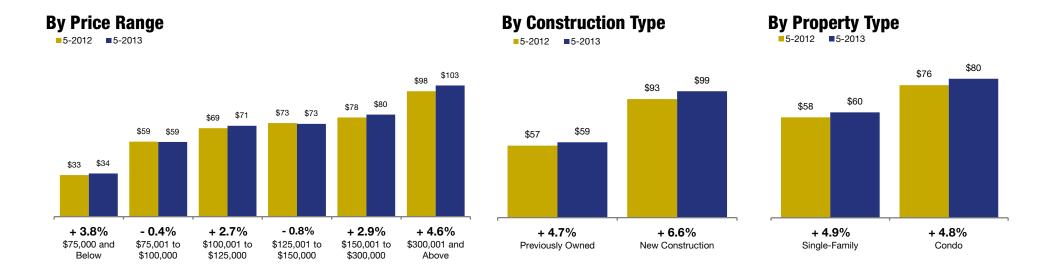
